The Ladies' Library Association (LLA) of Kalamazoo is an historic and dynamic 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. In 1844, it was established as a women's sewing and reading circle. The group was formally founded as the Ladies' Library Association in 1852 and has since been an important part of the Greater Kalamazoo area.

The Association influenced the development of women's organizations throughout the upper Midwest. It is the oldest women's club in Michigan and likely the second oldest continuing club in the nation. It also established the first lending library in the Kalamazoo.

Founding member Lucinda Hinsdale Stone, a nationally known educator and world traveler, helped create the LLA's reputation as a "college for women." Then and today the LLA promotes literacy and the arts, advocates for women's issues, and supports community outreach.

As a member of the LLA, there is an opportunity to engage with other women through a variety of projects, interests, and events. Members contribute their time and talents throughout the year to support the organization, the community, and its historic 1878 building.

Our signature projects include Books for Babies (distribution of children's books to various local service organizations) and Seita Scholars (supporting aged-out foster students at Western Michigan University). There are also options to join a variety of special interest groups, such as travel, gardening, writing, walking, book club, and others.

The LLA is open to all women 18 years and older who value our mission: *To enrich the community through literacy, arts and culture, and to preserve the LLA building and its history.*
